

SCUBAPRO FUN BUOY/VEST

USER MANUAL:

This product is designed for use on the surface as a visual signal (serving as a buoy or as a supportive flotation device (lifting vest)).

Caution: Improper use can be life-threatening. This product must not be used by individuals who are not familiar with handling it.

This device is not a lifesaving device and is not suitable as a standalone swimming or rescue aid (it does not fully guarantee that the user will remain on the surface; it is a supportive element).

Before us:

- Before use, all parts must be checked. If any part is found to be damaged or defective, the product must not be used. In this case, it will be assessed by an authorized SCUBAPRO dealer.
- Please ensure, before use, that the snorkeling buoy is fully inflated and securely stored in its case.

1. If you are using the product as a buoy – visual signal

- Open the pocket and remove the snorkeling buoy.
- Inflate it using the mouthpiece.
- Keep the buoy above the water in a vertical position.

2. If you are using the product as a buoyancy device (vest)

- Open the pocket and remove the snorkeling buoy.
- Inflate it using the mouthpiece.
- Connect both ends together and zip it up. Then, pull the vest over your head.
- Fasten the belt around your hips and securely close the buckle.

Care and Maintenance:

- Remove the snorkeling buoy from the zippered pocket.
- Rinse with clean water and ensure that all foreign objects are removed.
- Allow the buoy to air dry.
- Store in a cool, dry place. Avoid direct sunlight or excessive heat.
