Maintenance Instructions for Suits and Shoes

The company AGAMA was founded in 1991 and primarily manufactures neoprene suits for diving, rescue services, and other water sports. The company is known for its significant efforts in research and development, as well as for exclusively using high-quality materials and modern technology. AGAMA also provides service and repairs for all types of neoprene and membrane suits for diving, rescue services, and other water sports. Neoprene suits are made from high-quality neoprene material. The neoprene is covered on both sides with nylon fabric, optionally with fleece on the inside, or it may have no inner lining. Among other advantages, this material is characterized by an extraordinary degree of flexibility without losing any of its protective properties for the body. To maintain the suit's properties, it is necessary to take proper care of it. With proper handling and appropriate maintenance, the suit can last for a very long time, the same applies to neoprene shoes. Suits that are entirely or partially made of Lycra materials (nylon, spandex) have similar maintenance rules as neoprene suits. This material is very comfortable to wear, protects against UV radiation and other weather conditions. One of its advantages is its very quick drying after being soaked in water.

MAIN MAINTENANCE RULES FOR NEOPRENE SUITS (SHOES):

- 1. When soiled, use only soap (or shampoo recommended by the manufacturer for washing neoprene products) and clean water at a maximum temperature of +40°C.
- 2. After using suits in chlorinated water, seawater, or other contaminated water, rinse the suit (or shoes) with clean water after use.
- 3. If sand or other debris gets into the zipper, remove it with a soft brush.
- 4. After each use, allow the suit to dry thoroughly on both sides.
- 5. Hang the suit on a suitable hanger to dry and store. NEVER DRY IN DIRECT SUNLIGHT OR NEAR HEATING SOURCES.
- 6. For minor mechanical damage to the suit, you can use the adhesive provided by us; for major damage, we recommend sending the suit to us for repair.
- 7. For suits where the sleeves and legs are finished with cuffs that have a smooth inside, THESE CUFFS MUST BE TURNED UPWARDS WHEN PUTTING ON THE SUIT. Any tearing or similar damage to the cuff will not be covered under warranty.
- 8. When fastening the back zipper, YOU MUST HOLD THE LOOP AT THE BOTTOM OF THE ZIPPER to prevent it from tearing or becoming otherwise damaged. Any tearing or similar damage will not be covered under warranty.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USING ADHESIVE:

- 1. Gently apply the adhesive to the degreased (bonding) surfaces of the neoprene.
- 2. After a slight drying, press the surfaces together.
- 3. Hand-sew the damaged fabric with a cross stitch from both sides (do not sew through completely).

Warranty

The product comes with a 24-month warranty. The warranty does not cover wear and tear caused by normal use (e.g., wear on cuffs, etc.). The warranty covers the responsibility that the suit, at the time of delivery and during the warranty period, will have all the properties corresponding to a properly functioning suit. The responsibility for defects that occur during the warranty period is limited to the obligation to remedy these defects free of charge, either by repairing or replacing the defective product (or part) with a new one. The warranty does not apply in cases where the product has been mishandled, mechanically or chemically damaged, or if the wrong size suit was selected. Warranty claims during the warranty period must be submitted to the seller without undue delay after discovering the defect, together with proof of purchase.
